Traineeship grant: 554€/month
- **DOUBLE DIPLOMA (4+2 program)**
Pursue 2 years in France after 4 years in China
Common 5-6 months internship during the last year
Obtain the Dual Degree
- **PhD in 3 years**

Selection criteria:

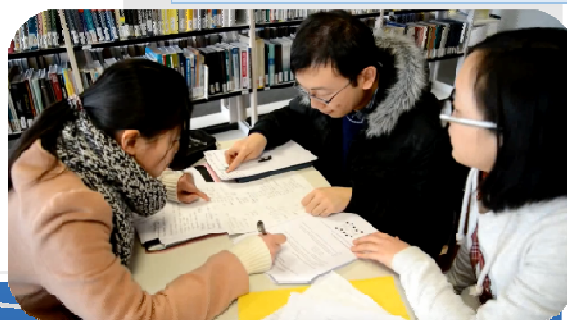
Project and motivation, GPA, language level

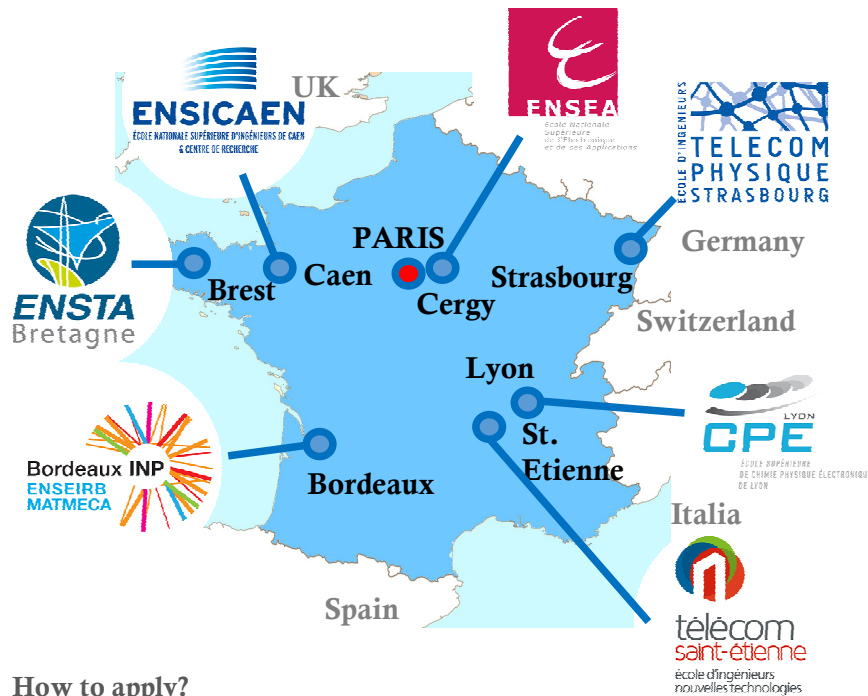
